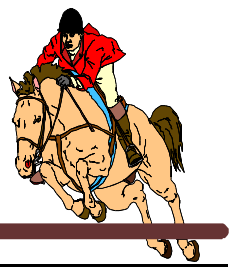

 Please ensure you are using appropriate tack and approved bits.

The Dressage Ring will run from 9am to 12pm, no allocated times will be given. All entries must be made through the Secretary (pre-entry and on day), start tickets will be issued for each class entered, riders are responsible for registering their number with the steward at the dressage ring when they are ready to compete. The rider is required to inform the Judge which test they will be riding before starting. This system has been adopted to avoid conflict with other classes. Each horse and rider combination may only enter each class once.

A registration card must be completed & signed by the secretary on the day. Visit www.cricklands.com for further information & rules.

Classes 34, 35 are Championship of Great Britain Dressage Qualifiers – A score of 58% or over in any Prelim or Novice test qualifies horse / pony rider combination for the Championships to be held at the David Broome Event Centre. A registration card must be completed & signed by the secretary on the day. Visit www.cricklands.com for further information & rules.

Equifest Qualifiers

This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at the East of England Show Ground on 12-16 August 2015. The two highest exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter that horse/pony for the Equifest Championship show. For up to date qualification eligibility information and rules please visit www.equifest.org.uk It is the responsibility of the owner to verify their qualification with Equifest.

RULES

- 1) All persons attending the show do so at their own risk and the organisers will not be held responsible for any accident occurring to competitors, horses, spectators or damage to any vehicle at any time however caused.
- 2) The Judges decision is final
- 3) All persons mounted must wear a hard riding hat conforming to the current acceptable British standard.
- 4) Whips longer than 30" are not permitted.
- 5) The organisers reserve the right to change or cancel any class or refuse entry.
- 6) Any complaint must be reported in writing, together with a fee of £10.00 to the Secretary within 10 minutes of the close of the class. If the complaint is upheld the £10.00 will be refunded
- 7) No Horses to be warmed up or exercised in the vicinity of the dressage arena.
- 8) No galloping outside the rings.
- 9) All perpetual trophies & cups are to be returned prior to next year's show.
- 10) There will be a £10 deposit required for all Trophies
- 11) Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 12) No Horses under 4 years, except for In-Hand
- 13) Any abuse of whips/spurs will not be tolerated and competitors will be asked to leave the showground.
- 14) It is the competitor's responsibility not to enter two classes that appear likely to clash. In the event of this arising the competitor must decide which class they will enter.
- 15) The Organisers strongly recommend that body protectors are worn when jumping.
